

Konstam's Scapa Flow an Osprey Fortress Series entry about the Royal Navy's wartime fleet anchorage in Northern Scotland. Britain's main battle fleet based itself out of the natural harbor at Scapa Flow, a strategically important natural harbor in the Orkney Islands. Scapa Flow served as Britain's main fleet anchorage during World Wars I and II. It held Jellicoe's Grand Fleet from 1914-18 and it was from here that it sailed out to do battle with the Germans at Jutland in 1916. In 1914 the British began building a comprehensive defensive network by fortifying the entrances to Scapa Flow and then extending these defenses to cover most of Orkney. These static defenses were well-written and interesting, but on a subject of importance that has been largely ignored. The defenses are presented as a unified whole, protecting against surface, submerged, and aerial attack. This book is recommended to those with a wide range of interests.
